Commissioner Donelon Names Jeffrey Zewe Director of Louisiana Automobile Theft and Insurance Fraud Prevention Authority

Commissioner of Insurance Jim Donelon announced today that Jeffrey Zewe has been appointed to the position of Director of the Louisiana Automobile Theft and Insurance Fraud Prevention Authority (LATIFPA) at the Louisiana Department of Insurance (LDI). Zewe's appointment is effective immediately.

"We are very pleased to have Jeff join the Department and lead the efforts of the auto theft and insurance fraud prevention authority," said Donelon. "His background in both legal and legislative work makes him a good fit to lead the agency in continuing its mission to deter and reduce vehicle theft and insurance fraud throughout Louisiana."

Zewe received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from the University of New Orleans and his Juris Doctorate from the Loyola University of New Orleans College of Law. Before joining the LDI, Zewe worked in the private sector as an attorney and also served as a Legislative Assistant.

Created during the 2004 Louisiana Regular Legislative Session, LATIFPA is a public agency housed within the LDI's Division of Insurance Fraud. Through statewide partnerships with law enforcement agencies, public awareness campaigns and various education initiatives, LATIFPA works to combat motor vehicle theft, insurance fraud and other criminal acts.
